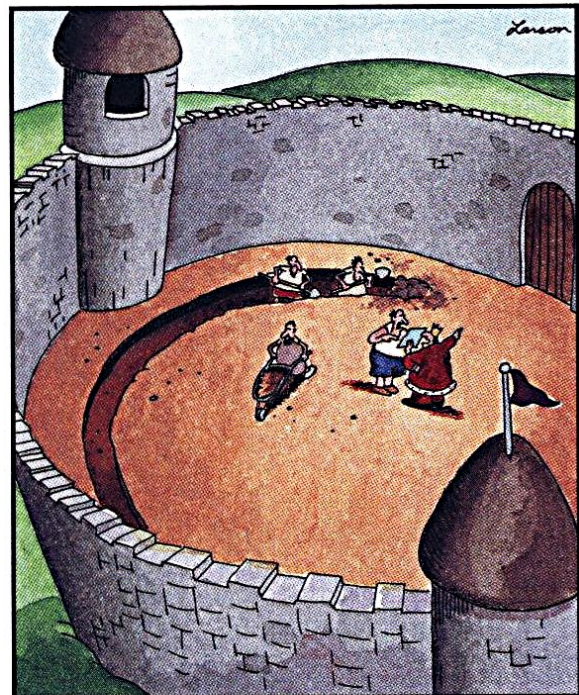
Are you just starting to do Construction Administration? This course will give you the knowledge to handle the construction process and the confidence to succeed.

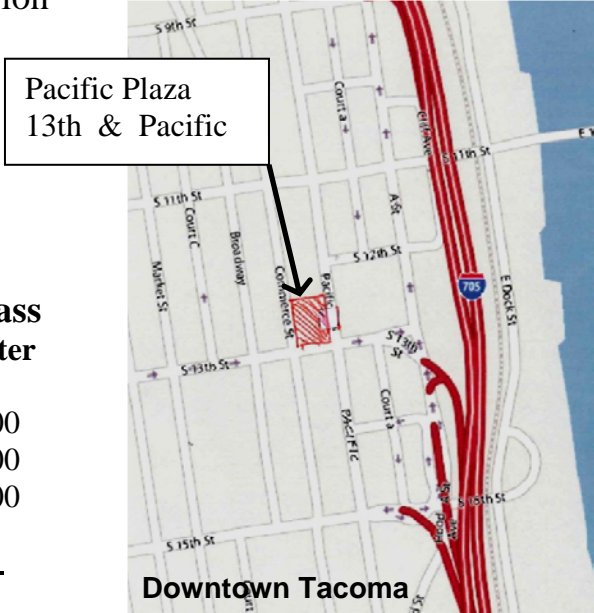
